### AHS Graduation Requirements

Twenty-one and three-quarter credits are required for graduation. The following credits are required:

Semester classes meet for 46 minutes in length and are held five times a week for eighteen weeks.

All classes, except band and chorus, earn .5 credits per semester.

### Grade Point Average/Class Rank

The Grade Point Average is computed by adding the value of the grades of all subjects studied and dividing the total by the number of courses studied.

All grades earned in classes offered at Annawan High School during the regular school year with the exception of Physical Education, are used in computing class rank. Class rank is computed at the end of each semester.

The standard method for converting from Annawan High School's 5.0 scale to a standard 4.0 scale is to subtract 1 from the total GPA. (Example: A 4.76 on Annawan's scale would be considered a 3.76 on a 4.0 scale.)

### Weighted Grading System

Annawan High School has the following courses that earn a weighted grade:

*^Indicates courses that can be taken as Dual Enrollment, but are not taught by AHS teacher so their grade is not included in student's high school GPA.*

In weighted courses letter grades from A through C- are increased by 1 unit. (Example: A- from 4.7 to 5.7)
